The road sweeper has been requested through the village and the clerk has asked that the parish council are notified when it is coming to enable flyers to be put on cars advising. Verge markers by Cottons Corner were damaged by the highways contractor and need replacing. The pavements through the village need clearing of weeds. The traffic calming area at the Cradley end of the village needs tidying. The clerk is to investigate the possibility of street lighting between the village hall and school within the 30mph zone bearing in mind that it is in the conservation area. <b>RESOLVED</b>

7.0	Correspondence / Discussion / Governance			
	a) To Receive Report from Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group			
	Herefordshire Council have adopted the Core Strategy. The NDP currently at regulation 16 was compliant with the Core Strategy at the time it was submitted. However modifications since made to Herefordshire Council's Core Strategy now make Bosbury's NDP at odds with the adopted Core Strategy and in its current form would be turned down by the inspector. Further meetings will be held to correct the anomalies and the plan resubmitted. <b>RESOLVED</b>			
	b) To receive update on Herefordshire Council's Core Strategy			
	Herefordshire Council adopted the Core Strategy on 16 <sup>th</sup> October. 29 Conservatives voted for, no votes were cast against and there were 16 abstentions – 12 Labour, 3 Independent and 1 It's Our County.			
	c) To discuss Request to Appoint Member of Parish Council onto Bosbury Parish Hall Committee			
	The chairman had approached Liz Cooke from Bosbury hall committee to see if she was interested in becoming a parish councillor. She has agreed and the parish council are minded to co-opt her at the December meeting.	ALL		
	d) To discuss Defibrillator for Bosbury Village			
	Cllr Baker has spoken to BT who would be happy for the kiosk to be adopted for £1 and the telephone equipment removed, although the electricity and light would still be supplied. The British Heart Foundation would part fund a defibrillator. Community Heartbeat is another option. They do not give funding but do lease the equipment, replace the consumables, give annual service checks and give more help. The parish council would need to provide insurance. 5 year costs are around £2100. Possible locations were suggested, with the parish hall being the most suitable. Cllr Baker will arrange a meeting with a defibrillator expert to discuss the best options. <b>RESOLVED</b>			
	e) To Agree Contract for Website Administrator			
	The clerk has sent an email advising that the existing quote costs have been agreed and that the position will be reviewed in May each year, a quote for ongoing monthly charges of £100 was received. Other organisations are to be approached for articles and sponsorship. 	The chairman asked that a letter be sent to Bosbury Cubs thanking them for sweeping around the footpaths and graveyard. The lengthsman is to be asked to strim around the planters. The clerk was asked to chase up the repair to the foot bridge at Swinmoor. Cllr Joyce-Townsend has responded to enquiries from four parish councils' of Herefordshire about the traffic calming scheme. 	The clerk has received the formal lengthsman annual plan of works contract from Balfour Beatty. These will be signed and forwarded to both Herefordshire Council and the lengthsmen. 	The Bosbury to Colwall road has seen an increase in both vehicle numbers and the speed of vehicles. After a recent accident on a blind bend at Slatchwood it was decided to ask if road signs could be put up advising of dangerous bend. Another suggestion was to install kerbstones to help prevent vehicles falling into the ditch. Signs for Brook Lane are also to be chased. The clerk and Cllr Joyce-Townsend will pursue. <b>RESOLVED</b>
