7.0	To Receive Update on Proposed developments in Bosbury	
	The Church Commissioners are not thought to be going to argue against the appeal refusal of the development behind the school.  The inspector has made a site visit to the proposed site at "Beanfield", and the appeal decision is due	
	by 23 <sup>rd</sup> October. Although the cut-off date for comments was 21 <sup>st</sup> August it has been noted that paperwork is still being accepted into the planning inspectorate website.	

## 8.0 Correspondence / Discussion / Governance a) To Receive Report from Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group Herefordshire Council are due to adopt the Core Strategy on 16th October. The NDP currently at regulation 16 was compliant with the Core Strategy at the time it was submitted. However modifications since made to Herefordshire Council's Core Strategy now make Bosbury's NDP (and other Herefordshire parishes) at odds with the Core Strategy should it be adopted on the 16th, because the NDP would need to allow for 39 new houses rather than the 16 it currently allows for. If the Core Strategy is adopted the NDP will have to go back to regulation 14 stage and another public consultation will have to take place. Cllr Hosking will draft a statement to be published to residents МН explaining of this issue. RESOLVED b) To discuss Extension of Conservation Area No successful progress has been made on this matter so it was AGREED to no longer pursue at present. RESOLVED c) To discuss Green Spaces Grant Option Cllr Joye-Townsend has explored this scheme but it is deemed to be too costly and have no relevance to anything in the parish. d) To discuss Request to Appoint Member of Parish Council onto Bosbury Parish Hall Committee The clerk had received a letter from Bosbury Parish Hall Committee requesting that a member of the parish council also be a member of the hall committee to improve communication between the groups. It was AGREED that the chairman will speak to someone on the hall committee to see if they SB are interested in becoming a parish councillor. Deferred to November meeting. e) To discuss Defibrillator for Bosbury Village Cllr Baker has further explored this issue and the costs involved. BT are to be asked for their stance on defibrillators being placed in phone boxes. The parish hall committee are happy for a defibrillator to be placed at an agreed location outside the hall. The parish council would need to contribute 36% Clerk / of the total cost and the British Heart Foundation contribute 64%. The defibrillator cost is around J Baker £500 but should a cabinet be required to hold it that would cost around £700 - £1000. Cllr Baker and the clerk will explore further and report at the November meeting. f) To Agree Contract for Website Administrator The clerk is to send a letter advising that the existing quote costs have been agreed and that the position will be reviewed in May each year, but to ask for a quote for ongoing monthly charges. Clerk **RESOLVED** 9.0 Highways / Footpaths a) To discuss any new highway or footpath issues The clerk was asked to report that an ash tree which was formerly reported as suffering from ash die back has not been removed, other ash trees in its vicinity are not yet showing signs of the disease. It Clerk is on a footpath by the hall and a possible danger to walkers. A ditch between Merrins drive and opposite Stanley House needs digging out to allow ater flow. The clerk has chased and is awaiting the formal lengthsman annual plan of works contract from Balfour Beatty. The clerk has received notification that the Definitive Map Modification Officer has made a recommendation that byeway M228 in Catley be open to all traffic in his final report to Herefordshire Council. A final decision is still to be made. b) To discuss Speed Indicator Devices Cllr Joyce-Townsend has approached Eardisley parish council about detail of their SID and awaits a JJT Clerk response. The clerk is to ask the lengthsman to always clear away cuttings when mowing the grass veraes. 10.0 Finance: a) To agree Finance Report and Note Bank Balances The finance report was agreed. Bank balances as at 4th September 2015 were current account £8553.97 and business reserve £5004.44 noted.
